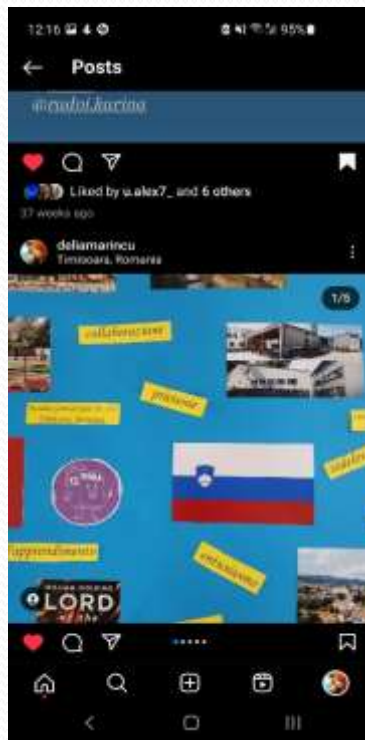

Pictures were posted on Facebook and Instagram, and the event is going to be further disseminated.



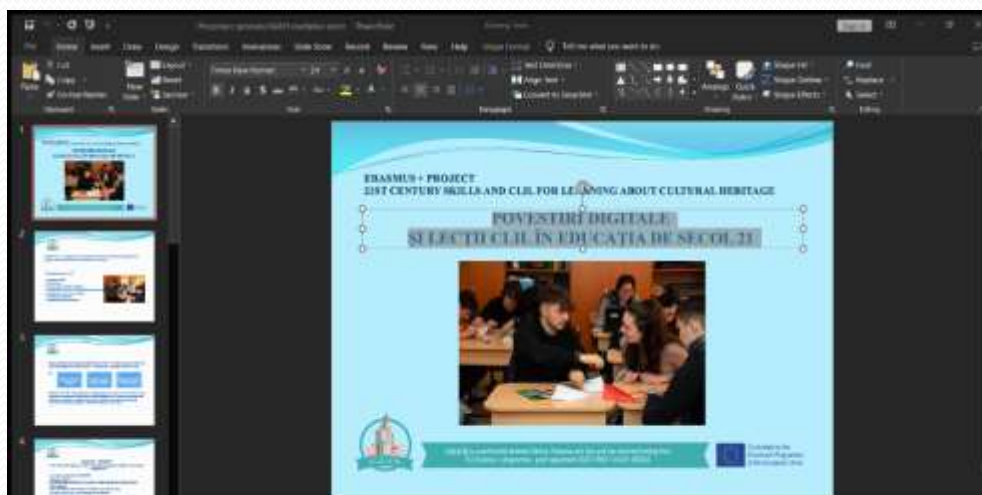
